- During Training: 10,000 per month (Stipend)

- After Appointment: 25,000 per month + 15,000 Performance-Based Incentive

### **8. Contract & Bond:**

- The CHO post is purely contractual (not permanent).
- Selected candidates must serve for 3 years after training.
- A bond of 1,03,000 will be required before joining.

- 6-month Certificate Course in Community Health under Ayushman Bharat Health Centers.
- Exit Exam after training is mandatory to qualify for appointment.
